34th ISTS Instructions for Presenters at Poster Session

Last update: June. 1, 2023

Note: All of dates and time are shown based on JST (Japan Standard Time).

- 1. The Poster Session is held on-site and on-demand. All posters and presenters' email addresses will be open to the symposium participants on the paper handling system (<u>https://ists.confit.atlas.jp</u>). All presenters can choose presentation style of on-site or on-demand.
- 2. All presenters of the Poster Session are required to submit their preprints (full papers) similar to oral sessions. Please be aware that anyone who did not submit a preprint will not be allowed to present a poster. Please also refer to "Instructions for Authors" on the conference web site.
- 3. The Poster Session is scheduled for Thursday, June 8 in the foyer of *Kurumeza* (3rd floor). The session is open to participants from 5:40 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- 4. The Poster Session will include a *Shotgun Session*, during which on-site presenters will be asked to give a brief presentation of their poster to the participants within 30 seconds. The Shotgun Session starts from 5:55 p.m. Presentation materials, which are uploaded posters, will be projected on a screen by the secretariat.
- 5. Allocated area for each poster, which is indicated by the paper number, is 0.9 m (width) by 1.8 m (height) on a mounting panel. Fixing tools for display, such as pins, paste, or tape, will be provided at the session venue. The presenters can post their posters after 2:00 p.m. on Monday, June 5, and must post them by 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 8.
- 6. Poster should be one large sheet of paper. Alternatively, you can integrate several pages/figures on one sheet in a neat and clean fashion. Posters must be self-explanatory and must include paper numbers, paper titles, authors' names, and affiliations on the top.
- After the Poster Session, posters need to be removed by 2:00 p.m. on Friday, June
 9. Any materials left might be disposed without notice.
- 8. Three best posters will be judged and voted by participants. Best Poster Award will be presented at the Closing Ceremony. Please join the ceremony not to miss this unforgettable moment!
